Third Mainline – 123rd Street to Cal Sag Channel

SCOPE OF WORK

Construction of a third main line along the Indiana Harbor Belt. Upgrading of some existing track at interlockings, which are locations where two tracks cross. Construction included a new rail bridge over 127th Street and associated signal work.

BENEFITS

Before completion of this project, freight trains destined to Barr and Blue Island Yards to the east waited at this location for access to the yards, creating congestion on the main line tracks. The new third main line track now provides additional capacity for trains passing through the area to proceed around trains waiting for yard access.


