1st Avenue and Union Pacific Grade Separation

SCOPE OF WORK

The project will consider eliminating the at-grade crossing at 1st Avenue by two Union Pacific tracks. This will be accomplished by creating either an overpass or underpass for vehicles.

BENEFITS

Daily, 26,800 vehicles pass through the crossing. The Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) estimates that weekday motorist delay at the region's grade crossings cost residents \$332 million in wasted productivity in 2018 alone. This project will reduce roadway congestion and improve safety at this location. It will also eliminate the potential for collisions between vehicles and trains.
